Species protected under ACAP. ACAP focuses on any species, subspecies or population of albatrosses and petrels listed in its Annex 1. It currently covers all 22 of the world's species of albatrosses of four genera, all seven species of petrels in the genera *Macronectes* (two species of giant petrels) and *Procellaria*, and two species of shearwaters in the genera *Ardenna* and *Puffinus*, all of which belong to the avian tubenose order Procellariiformes.

The Agreement on the Conservation of Albatrosses and Petrels is a legally binding international agreement signed in 2001 and entered into force on 1 February 2004 when South Africa ratified as the fifth Party to the Agreement. It was created in order to halt the drastic decline of seabird populations in the Southern Hemisphere, particularly of albatrosses and petrels. Albatrosses and

petrels are threatened by introduced species on their breeding islands, pollution, and by being taken as bycatch
